Marcus Borg is a member of the Jesus Seminar and a popular lecturer in the United States. His talk used the same material in his books but with a different slant.

His title: - deeply divided Christians was discussed.

The mainline Christians were deeply divided over a number of different topics eg the status of gays/lesbians. There were two different paradigms
A paradigm is described as a way of seeing a whole (eg the solar system before and after Copernicus).

The Bible is literally true eg Genesis. a divine product and consequences

Exclusive revelations

Christian life is faith central: belief in the afterlife is very important. Also sin, guilt, forgiveness of sins

All of the above concepts are really quite modern not ancient

Fundamentalists numerically dominant in the United States

Millions have left church because of the above ideas

Since 1965, a decrease of 40 per cent in congregations

The earlier paradigm is no longer persuasive to a large section of the public

Roots in Enlightenment

Dominant in seminaries in last 40 years. Is now taking root

Features: - non-doctrinal

Historical/metaphorical

They are human product not divine

No denial of the reality of god

The bible :not how it happened: metaphysical/ metaphorical: - fresh meaning according to the age in which it is read.

Thomas Mann a definition of myth: story about the way things never were but always are. Bible is true and some of it happened

Difference between Spong and Borg and ;Himself and Cupitt in their concept of god

The world has reached a critical point: the future is global
There is going to be a common future or no future at all!
The evolution of cultures is based on symbols
Culture/language discriminate us from the other animals
He is humanistic: human creation:
This worldly. There is one vast physical universe with eternal laws and evolving.
The world is secular not religious
Religion =supernatural, Secular this worldly
The second axial age: led to a modern global second world
It emerged out of the JC tradition: William of Ockham: : renaissance humanists:
Erasmus:Luther : John Locke
Post Christian led to rules and customs of Christianity.
Fundamentalists: support superstition
Incarnation led to humanisation of god .

Enlightenment : think for yourself: publish: speak
Kingdom of God in the secular world.
Human coming-of-age: Kingdom of God in secular world
Inherent worth-not divine

Jack believes there is something out there called god

Don believes that there is nothing outside our human experience-our language-our world.

He illustrated this by talking about an Atlas: if you take everything on the map there is nothing left

Perception=interpretation

2). The TV show Simpsons is a work of art: it is full of irony and all aspects of US life are mocked. In this way it is like a Jane Austen novel. Regarding the state of religion in Springfield: one member of the family is a fundamentalist: but the rest of liberal Protestants. The Simpson family are typical of US church attenders. The minister is Reverend Lovejoy who is an intellectual disaster: says eg God loves us victims

The axial age was defined by Karl Jaspers after 1st WW

The first age was between 800 BC and 200 C E

Axial=pivotal: major turnaround

Budda, Confucius, Socrates and the Jewish Prophets

The second axial age started in the 16th century when the agrarian society changed into a technological age. There were no spiritual Greats

Many religious views were difficult to believe

Plato:

1).Myth=meaning

2). Logos(reason): practical, logical, rational, mathematics, medicine.

Need for both myth and logos

Myth=meaning leads to religion: life has ultimate meaning

In the second axial age, logos increased and myth decreased

Myth=timeless truth, related to ritual eg mass

Yearning for Ecstasy-ideas-transcendence

Ecstasy=standing out side oneself

Transcendence=goes beyond

In the first axial age, God was not defined

Trinity=not a simple personality (eg Gregory of Nicaea three goes to one, one and goes to 3)

Theology=poetry=lift

Not necessary to define God

Pre modern: live first then you'll understand

Live=nirvana

Religion=ethical alchemy

Living ethically will change you

Jesus did not talk about God but doing good, healing, leaving a good life

Koran: why argue about the divinity of Jesus

Live a good life good to share your life

Judaism: Tora: doing things

Religion=doing things which transform

Jesus a rebel

Budha: speak truth within yourself
